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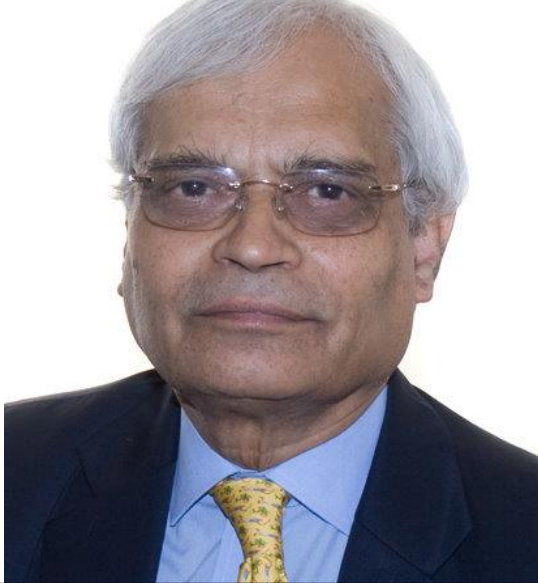

The research



The Masters by Research has been designed to suit candidates from a range of backgrounds and disciplines. It is particularly suitable if you aspire to a research-based career or as preparation for undertaking a PhD.

Duration: One Year

Medium Instruction: English

Delivery Methods: Blended Learning and Supervision

What will I study?

You will produce a research dissertation. A research training and development programme will help you towards this goal.

Compulsory research training sessions will cover aspects of research design, research data management and research project management. These sessions will enable you to identify, evaluate and construct arguments, design research questions, and make a contribution to knowledge. Ethics, values and equality in research will also be considered.

You will also be required to select six further sessions from a range of options focusing on methodological considerations in the sciences, social sciences, and arts and humanities.

Continued:

How will I study?

Research degrees are focused on independent study, allowing you a great deal of control over the pace and direction of your individual research project, with the expert guidance and support of your supervisor(s).

Research training takes place by Zoom and the schedules & time table will be notified by email.

How will I be assessed?

The first element of the MRes (research project registration) will be assessed through the production of a research proposal, a project management plan and a skills development portfolio. This will take place after approximately three months if you are studying full-time or six months part-time.

The final assessment of your individual research project will be through a dissertation as well as a *viva voce* examination.

Continued:

Who will be teaching me?

Being a research degree, you will not be taught through lectures, as the various training sessions are discussion based, however your research project will be supported by a supervisor.

The completion of your individual research project will be supported by regular supervision meetings with an expert in your chosen field of study by zoom.

Facilities

As a postgraduate research student, you will be registered in the University's Graduate School supported by the designated supervisor.


Departmental facilities are complemented by the University library which stocks around 200,000 items, including books, journals, e-resources and multimedia. In addition, you can access PCs, laptops, software and assistive technologies.

Career Prospects

What are my career prospects?

Masters by Research students have many options, there are skilled work permits in UK, <https://www.gov.uk/skilled-worker-visa> EU, Canada and the USA.

The skills and experience acquired through an MRes will provide ideal preparation for progressing to higher research qualifications, such as MPhil and PhD, or pursuing a research-based career.

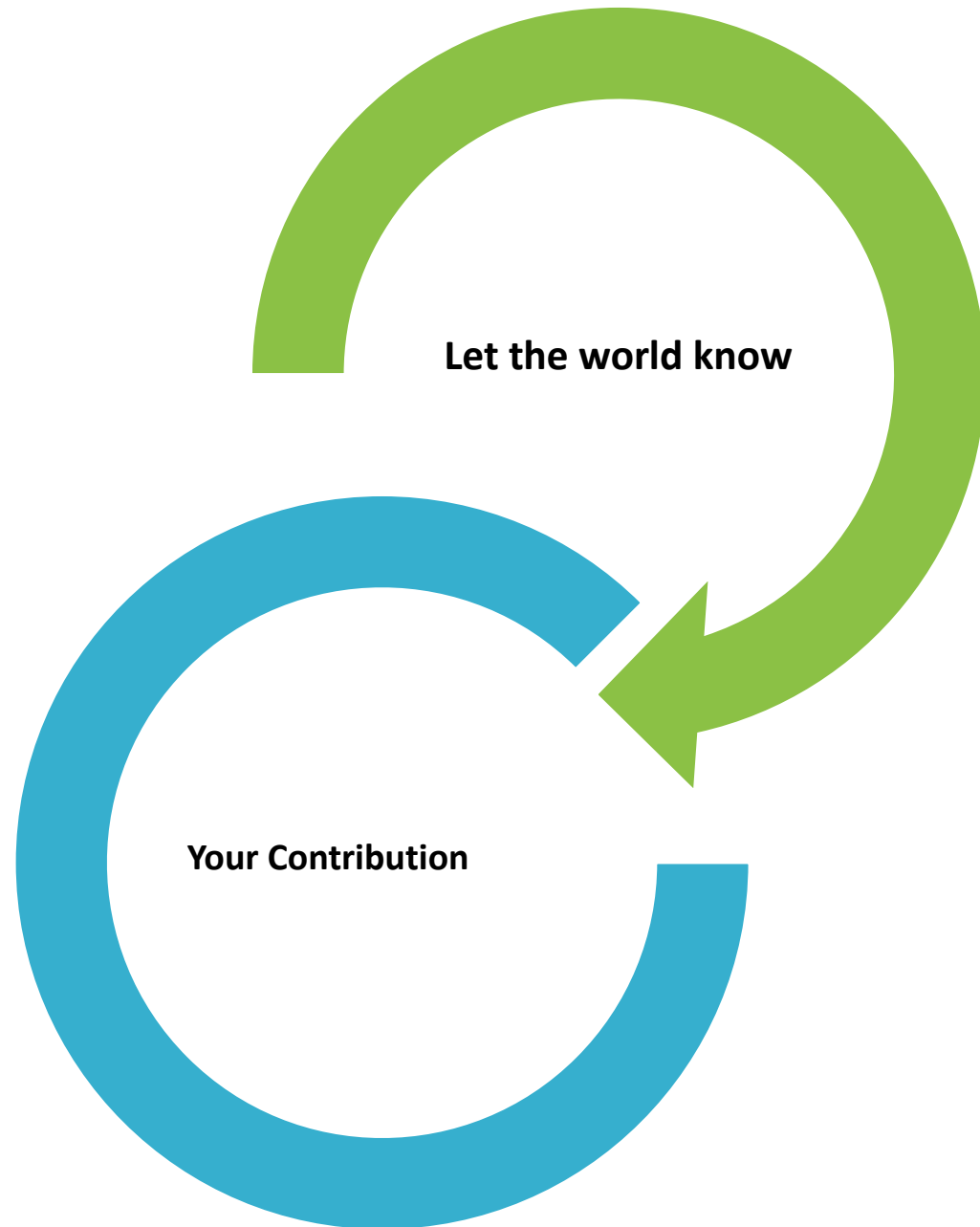
It takes a little while to consider an application because each application has to be assessed by prospective supervisors and there has to be an interview.
